Acknowledgments

The 2005 lowa Youth Survey (IYS) would never have been completed without the assistance and support of several organizations and individuals. First, we would like to thank all the district superintendents, principals, teachers, counselors, facilitators, parents and students for an incredible effort. Survey participation increased from 85,426 in 1999 to almost 97,000 in 2002. In 2005, 98,246 students participated. The increases from 1999 to 2005 were due to the continued group effort in each district, which resulted in a high level of school participation.

We are especially grateful for the assistance provided by the Iowa Department of Human Rights, Division of Criminal and Juvenile Justice Planning (CJJP) and Statistical Analysis Center, the author of the 2002 Iowa Youth Survey reports. In an effort to make the data from the 1999, 2002, and 2005 Iowa Youth Surveys comparable to the maximum degree possible, we have drawn extensively on the prior work done by the CJJP and the Iowa Consortium for Substance Abuse Research, the author of the 1999 IYS reports, in terms of data management and analyses. Also, much of the narrative in this report borrows heavily from the Consortium's 1999 IYS reports. Hopefully, this report is viewed as carrying forward the quality of the CJJP and the Consortium's previous work. Any mistakes or other problems in the 2005 report, however, are due to its authors.

The other individuals and organizations that were involved in this collaborative effort are too numerous to mention in detail, but they included individuals from state and local government agencies, youth organizations, youth service providers, and private enterprise. Each and everyone who participated provided invaluable input into the product of those efforts, the 2005 IYS reports.

Thank you all for being a part of the 2005 collection and analyses of data on lowa's youth.

Important Information About This Report

What Can You Do With These Data

The 2005 lowa Youth Survey (IYS) State of lowa report was designed to help state-level planners identify youth development-related needs, develop relevant programs, and assess the outcomes of those programs. These data can help you better understand our youth and their needs. They can also help you assess the strengths and weaknesses of our schools, families, and communities from the young person's perspective. In addition, the data in this report help the state obtain funds for a wide variety of programs. At every step of the process—from needs identification, to program development and implementation, to program assessment—the 2005 IYS data will prove to be a valuable resource.

The state report can also help lowa's schools, area education agencies, and counties assess their relative strengths and weaknesses. The grades 6, 8, and 11, as well as male and female percentages reported in district-level, AEA-level, county-level, and other 2005 IYS reports can be compared with the respective state report percentages. The higher the proportion of students in each of these columns that completed usable IYS questionnaires, the more likely the comparisons with the state report percentages will be unbiased. Such comparisons should be considered exploratory, but for the most part are likely to be useful.

Overview and Comparison to Previous Surveys

Survey scope. The 2005 IYS is the 11th in a series of youth surveys that have been completed every three years since 1975. The 1999, 2002, and 2005, surveys differ from previous years in both the procedures used to implement the survey and the students that were asked to participate. Previous surveys were given to approximately one-third of lowa's public school districts and a sample of their 6th, 8th, 10th, and 12th grades. Starting with the 1999 IYS, participation was sought from all public school districts and all students in grades 6, 8, and 11, as well as 14-18 year-old students in alternative programs. These changes make it possible to provide youth development-related data for each participating school, as well as for each county in which participating students reside. They also make it more feasible to use IYS results to assess the outcome of community and school youth development programs. The changes do, however, restrict direct comparisons with surveys prior to 1999 to grades 6 and 8 and to those schools that participated in those surveys.

Starting with the 2002 IYS, participation was also sought from all non-public schools in the state. It was believed that by including all lowa students in the 6th, 8th, and 11th grades, the survey results would more accurately reflect the attitudes and perceptions of all lowa students in those grades, not just those attending public schools. These non-public data have been included in this report.

At a minimum, at least some survey questionnaires were completed in 359 of Iowa's 365 public school districts (98.4%), and in 27 of the 194 non-public schools (13.9%), with some combination of students enrolled in the 6th, 8th and/or 11th grades. A total of 98,246 students across the state completed the IYS, with each county represented by at least 241 students, except Adams County (181 students) and Ringgold County (151 students). A total of 95,895 students in public school districts and 2,351 students in non-public school districts participated in the survey.

Survey content. The 2005 IYS questionnaire includes questions about the students' behaviors and attitudes/beliefs, as well as their perceptions of their peer, family, school and neighborhood/community environments. Prior research has shown that each of these environments plays a significant role in positive youth development. Selection of specific survey questions was based on a combination of: 1) analysis of data collected in previous lowa Youth Surveys; 2) a literature review of the established youth development models, especially those that enjoy some acceptance in lowa; and 3) discussion sessions with youth development professionals (community service providers, school district personnel and academics).

The general content of the questions included in the 2005 IYS is similar to that of previous surveys. Most of the items are relevant to the constructs on which previous IYS were based. Most of the questions and responses from the 2002 IYS were utilized without modification, and several new questions added. Among the new additions in 2005 are questions related to bullying; exercise, diet, and weight; and grades.

The appropriateness of any comparison between the 1999, 2002, and 2005 surveys, and surveys from previous years, must be considered on a question-by-question basis. Trend analyses for the most part should be considered exploratory at best. If comparisons are made, the 1999, 2002, and 2005 reports may make your district *appear* to be significantly different, for better or worse, from the reports generated by previous surveys. This appearance may be due to differences in question wording and the representativeness of the sample rather than to actual changes in lowa's youth.

Data Editing/Cleaning

Validity checks. The 2005 IYS questionnaire, like its predecessors, is a self-administered questionnaire that relies on each student's ability to read (a few students may have had the questionnaire read to them) and honestly respond to each question. Such self-reported behaviors and attitudes/beliefs are always subject to falsification, either intentional (denial, boasting or just mischievousness) or unintentional (mistakenly filling in the wrong circle, misreading, etc.). Each questionnaire was reviewed for evidence that would support a claim that the respondent had little or no intention of making an honest effort to complete the 2005 IYS. This evidence consisted of such things as inconsistent responses (e.g., indicating use of substances on one question while denying ever using them on another), improbable responses (e.g., using every illegal drug every day), and patterned responses (e.g., answering a series of questions exactly the same way). There were a total of 26 such validity checks made. A total of 142 questionnaires failed four or more of the 26 validity checks, and these questionnaires were deleted from the data files used to generate the 2005 IYS reports. This left a usable total of 98,104 questionnaires.

Other cleaning. In addition to the validity checks described above, some individual questions in the 2005 IYS questionnaire were found to have responses that were improbable or erroneous. These questions included county of residence and age.

<u>County of residence</u>. When we compared county of residence to the county in which the student's school district was located, we found students from nearly every school district across the state reporting that they resided in lowa County. It was evident that there were several students confusing their county of residence with their state of residence. There were similar problems involving county and city confusions (e.g., Des Moines). There were also several students who provided a response that could not be used to clearly identify a county of residence.

Because of these problems, the county of residence responses were modified in the following two ways: 1) The county in which the school district's administrative office was located served as the focal county for that district. Any response to the county of residence question that was not the focal county, or one of the counties that shared a geographic border with that county, was converted to the county where the majority of the students from that school district claimed as their county of residence. 2) If a student provided no useable response for county of residence, the county that the majority of students from that school district claimed as their county of residence was assigned to those students. While these modifications will still allow for some students being assigned to the wrong county of residence and even a few who might have been taken out of the correct county and put into an incorrect one, the modified version of county of residence is much more likely to contain fewer errors than the unedited county of residence responses.

<u>Age</u>. Some responses to the age question in the 2005 IYS were also modified. There were several instances where only one digit of the age response was reported. If the missing digit was the first digit, and the second digit was consistent with an age that was appropriate to the respondent's reported grade in school, the missing first digit was replaced with a "1". The same procedure was used to convert a "0" to a "1" if the age response was "08" or less. *For example,* if a student reported that he/she was in the 8th grade and reported an age of 03 (0 for the first digit and 3 for the second digit), the age response was changed to 13 (1 for the first digit and 3 for the second digit). After the above changes were made, any student who reported an age of less than 10, or more than 19, was converted to missing data for the age question response.

The responses to all other questions remain unchanged from those actually provided by the students. In every instance, it is important to remember that the responses recorded are each student's *perceptions*, not necessarily the actual state of the environment they are describing. Still, a case can be made that students almost surely behave *in response to their perception* of what is occurring, and thus it is their perception that is most important.

Profile of Level of Participation in the State

Table 1 below provides a profile of the extent to which students participated in the 2005 IYS. The first column is the number of students enrolled in grades 6, 8, and 11 in lowa,

according to the Iowa Department of Education. The second column is the number of students who reported that they were in grades 6, 8, and 11 and completed a usable 2005 IYS questionnaire. The third column is the percentage of students completing a usable IYS questionnaire by each grade.

In general, the higher the percentage completing an IYS, the more likely the students in that grade are representative of all of the 6th, 8th, and 11th grade students residing in the state.

Specific Report Content

Constructs. The section with the constructs is new in 2005. The data are combined for selected questions and presented in easy-to-read charts. Thirty-four constructs, within nine framework domains, are included. Constructs from 1999 and 2002 IYS data are available in the IYS Trend Report—1999 and 2002, on line at http://www.iowayouthsurvey.org. A listing of the framework domains and constructs follows.

Data report. The data provided in the 2005 IYS state report include the responses to every question that appears in the 2005 questionnaire. There are 11 columns on each page of the report. The symbol "—" appearing in any column indicates data that are either not reportable or not applicable. Also, "0%" appearing in any column represents anything less than 0.5 (including 0 or none).

The **first column** includes an abbreviated version of the question (followed in parentheses by its section and question number in the 2005 IYS questionnaire), a "response" row for each response, and the "% who answered question" row. This last row in each set of responses is the percent of students who responded to that question. A low percentage in this row would indicate that several students did not, for one reason or another, answer that question. In general, the higher this percentage, the more likely the responses in the remaining rows are representative of students in lowa. All the percents in the "response" rows are based on the number of students who answered that question. Students who left the question blank or provided an unreadable response are not included.

The **next three columns**, titled "6th **Total**, 8th **Total**, and 11th **Total**," are weighted percents based on all of the students in lowa that answered the question and reported that they were in either grade 6, 8, or 11.

The **fifth column**, titled **"All grades,"** includes the percent of students who reported each of the responses. Note that the results in this column include all of the students in the previous three columns, as well as students who did not choose grade 6, 8, or 11 when asked to select their grade in school.

To obtain an <u>estimate of the total number</u> of students in each grade that responded in a particular way to any question, you can change the percent reported for that response in the appropriate column to a decimal and multiply that decimal by the enrollment numbers provided in Table 1 on page 5. For example, if, in the "grade 11" column, 50% of the 11th grade students who completed the IYS reported they never gamble, you would multiply .50 times the total 11th grade enrollment number reported in Table 1. The resulting product of the multiplication would be an *estimate* of the total number of 11th graders in your school district who reported they never gamble.

The **next six columns** show how each of the gender groups within each grade answered the question.

All column percentages are weighted. There were several schools that completed widely varying proportions of their 6th, 8th, and 11th grade students, and these differences present a significant potential for biases. Given that 11th graders are much more likely to be substance users than either 6th or 8th graders, any significant discrepancy between the proportion of 11th grade students and the other grades who took part in the 2005 IYS would produce a distorted total estimate for that school district (i.e., a larger proportion of 11th graders and a smaller proportion of 6th and 8th graders would produce an artificially high total substance use estimate in that school district).

In the school district reports, this source of bias is minimized by withholding certain data from those schools that did not submit surveys from 75% or more of their students from each grade. (Because of the increasing number of districts that participate in whole grade sharing, an exception to the 75% rule was made for these districts in the 2005 IYS with the 75% rule applied to only the grades for which the district had students.) In the Area Education Agency (AEA) reports, this is addressed by including in the report only those schools that submitted surveys from 75% or more of the students in each grade. For this state report, a statistical weighting procedure minimizes the potential biases and has the advantage of using all of the data that were collected.

<u>Weighting</u>. The proportion of students enrolled in each grade in the state was divided by the proportion actually completing an IYS. The resulting decimal was the weighting factor used in the report. Table 2 provides a descriptive profile of the weights used. The first column is the proportion of all the state's students enrolled in the 6th, 8th, and 11th grade. The second column is the proportion of students who reported they were in each grade level in the IYS sample.

The third column is the weight used to make the IYS population match the enrollment population. Students in the IYS sample that did not report a grade were assigned a

weight of 1. The weighted percents for each "response" row are the best estimates that can be obtained from the 2005 IYS at this time.

Substance use prevalence rates. A summary of ever and current (30 days) alcohol, tobacco and other drug (ATOD) use prevalence rates can be found on page 84. The following provides definitions of substance use prevalence rates for tobacco, alcohol, and other drugs.

<u>Tobacco</u>. The "any tobacco use—current" prevalence rate includes all students who indicated that they had used a tobacco product in the past 30 days: cigarettes, cigars or smokeless. These students include those who reported that they smoked at least part of a cigarette, or on some days smoking cigarettes or cigars, or used smokeless tobacco in the last 30 days. The respective IYS section and question numbers are B-15, B27-B28 and B37. The "any tobacco use—ever" prevalence rate includes all those students who reported any of the following: that they smoked at least part of a cigarette in the last 30 days; that they had ever tried to quit smoking cigarettes; an age when they started smoking cigarettes; some days of smoking cigarettes or cigars in the last 30 days; or that they used smokeless tobacco (B15-B17, B27-B28 and B37).

The "cigarette use–current" prevalence rate includes those students who reported they smoked at least part of one cigarette in the last 30 days, or reported some days of smoking cigarettes in the last 30 days (B15 and B27). The "cigarette use–ever" prevalence rate includes those students who reported that they smoked at least part of one cigarette in the last 30 days, that they had ever tried to quit smoking cigarettes, reported an age when they started smoking cigarettes, or reported some days of smoking cigarettes in the last 30 days. The respective IYS section and question numbers are B15-B17 and B27. The "cigar use–current" prevalence rate includes those students who reported some days of smoking cigars in the last 30 days (B28). No "cigar use–ever" prevalence rate is available. The "smokeless tobacco use–current" prevalence rate includes those students who reported using smokeless tobacco in the last 30 days (B37), and the "ever" prevalence rate includes those who reported that they had never used smokeless tobacco (B37).

<u>Alcohol</u>. The "any alcohol use–current" prevalence rate includes those students who had reported taking at least one drink (beer, wine, or liquor) in the last 30 days, or reported having 5 or more drinks on at least one day in the last 30 days. The section and question numbers from the 2005 IYS questionnaire that are respectively associated

with these criteria are B29 and B25. The "any alcohol use—ever" prevalence rate includes those students who reported an age that they started drinking, or reported drinking 5 or more drinks on at least one day in the last 30 days, or had at least one drink in the last 30 days. The section and question numbers respectively associated with these criteria are B18, B25 and B29.

<u>Drugs.</u> The "any drug use–current" prevalence rate includes those students who reported some use of a drug (marijuana, inhalant, methamphetamine, cocaine, amphetamine other than meth, steroid, or other illegal drug) in the past 30 days. The section and question numbers associated with these criteria are B30-B35 and B38-B39. The "any drug use–ever" prevalence rate includes all those students who indicated that they had ever used any of these drugs. These students include those who reported either an age for first using any one of these drugs, some use of these drugs in the last 30 days, or some ever use of steroids or other illegal drugs (B19-B23, B30-B35 and B38-B39). The "current" prevalence rate for each type of drug includes those students who reported some use of that drug in the last 30 days (B30-B35 and B38-B39). The "ever" prevalence rate for each type of drug includes those students who reported either an age for first using that drug (B19-B23), use of that drug in the last 30 days (B30-B35), or some use ever of steroids or other illegal drugs (B38-B39).

Some Cautions Regarding Interpretation

Unless every school district collected data from every student, there is always the possibility that the students who completed the 2005 IYS are not representative of all students in lowa. In general, the higher the proportion of students participating, the more likely the sample is representative and without bias. Still, only the school districts know exactly why some of the students did not participate, and only school district personnel can be fully aware of any biases that those non-participating students might introduce into the state report percentages.

The response percentages that are reported for any one question might total to slightly less or more than 100%. This is due to rounding, not an error in the reported percentages.

Other Available Reports

County and AEA. County- and AEA-level reports are available to the public. These reports are different in some respects from the state reports, but AEAs and counties will be able to use these reports to help integrate their data with state level aggregates. These reports can be accessed from the following website, http://www.iowayouthsurvey.org, as well the websites of other state agencies funding this study.

Planning regions. Additional reports are available that are based on other regional planning categories. These reports include the Iowa Department of Public Health's substance abuse and prevention planning regions, Iowa Department of Human Services regions, DECAT regions and judicial districts. These reports can be accessed from this

website, http://www.iowayouthsurvey.org, as well as county and state reports. These reports are also accessible on the websites of other state agencies funding this study.

Other reports. The Departments of Public Health, Education, Workforce Development, CJJP, and RISE are working together to develop other reports that can help local and state planning efforts. Please go to the IYS website periodically to check on the availability of such other reports.

Where Do We Go From Here

Long term. Our goal is for the 2005 IYS to be replicated in three-year intervals with continuous improvements. At this time, a survey of selected items is being developed that you may want to use in the interim years before the next implementation of the full IYS in 2008. It is expected that the selected survey items will be available in July 2006. These could be used for comparison of selected items to the 1999, 2002, and 2005 IYS, as well as to collect required data for grants and to provide key data about the Connectedness to School Construct. We also are studying the feasibility of an on-line version of the IYS for 2008.

Conducting this year's survey has been a learning experience for all of us, and with the knowledge gained, we expect subsequent surveys to be even more successful. Your comments and suggestions have been, and will continue to be, invaluable planning and implementation resources.

Targeted improvements. The lowa Youth Survey is a work in progress, and to further that progress, we hope to make the following improvements: (1) Persuade every public school district and every non-public school to participate in subsequent surveys. (2) Increase the percentage of students participating, with target percentages for designated grades reaching 85%, with the ideal being a full census (100%). Many of the reporting issues regarding potential biases and comparability will diminish as the number of participating students approaches a full census. (3) Develop a questionnaire that might be more appropriate to 4th, 5th, and 6th grade levels.


Part II: Constructs

These constructs are the product of an interactive process that began with a committee of State planners identifying hypothetical constructs and accompanying measures derived from the IYS. They were then subjected to additional theoretical consideration and empirical testing, with the results used to revise the constructs and measures, which were then reviewed and tested again and so on, until a consensus was reached on the content of each construct.


There are 34 core constructs organized into 9 groups. Each construct is measured by one or more questions relating to a specific topic area. If a student answered all of the questions for that area in a positive fashion (e.g., strongly agree, agree), then that student is included in the positive responses. If a student answered at least one of the questions in a negative fashion (e.g., disagree, strongly disagree), then that student is included among the negative responses for that construct.

In the report that follows, there is a graph that shows the percent of positive and negative responses for each gender within grade group. Below each graph is a list of the questions included in that construct.
